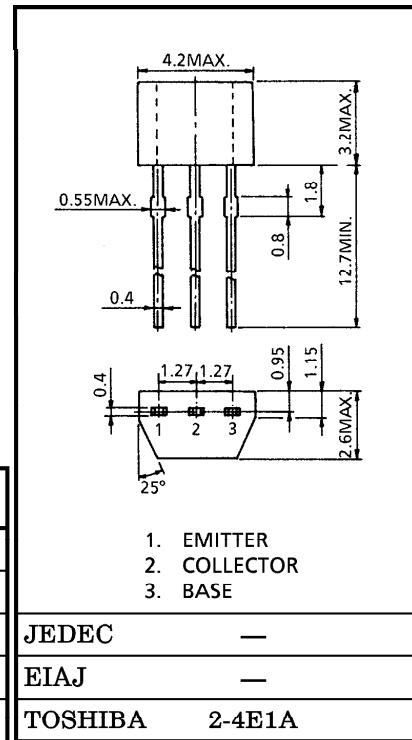

- Small Package
- High Voltage : $V_{CEO} = -50V$ (Min.)

- Excellent h_{FE} Linearity
: $h_{FE}(I_C = -0.1mA) / h_{FE}(I_C = -2mA) = 0.95$ (Typ.)
